The Metropolitan Transit Authority of Harris County is conducting a Call for Projects for the 5310 Enhanced Mobility of Seniors and Individuals with Disabilities grant program.

Congress establishes the funding for FTA programs through authorizing legislation that amends Chapter 53 of Title 49 of the U.S. Code. On December 4, 2015, President Obama signed the Fixing America's Surface Transportation (FAST) Act, reauthorizing surface transportation programs through Fiscal Year 2020. The FAST Act continued the 5310 Enhanced Mobility of Seniors and Individuals with Disabilities formula program established in MAP-21.
